### 1. Design Internship

- Gain a high level of proficiency in all design applications
- Work directly with the art director and designers on layouts and ads from start to finish
- Be a part of planning and styling photo shoots and upcoming issues, then watch your ideas blossom into print
- Complete at least 20 hours a week, for at least three months. (Minimum hours are necessary to stay involved in a constantly changing atmosphere)

### 2. Photography Internship

- Depending on your strengths, have upwards of 30 images in each issue
- Meet hundreds of people on assignment
- Go on Studio, portrait, in-house, and location shoots
- Gain knowledge from other professional photographers by assisting at photo shoots
- Learn the process from camera to layout by working directly with the art director and graphic designers as a team
- Complete at least 20 hours a week, for at least three months (Minimum hours are necessary to stay involved in a constantly changing atmosphere)

### 3. Illustration Internship

- Perform on-staff or at large
- Learn from art directors how to develop ideas conceptually
- Have your illustrations printed in a regional magazine

### Qualifications

- Hold a design degree or be a third-year art student at an accredited college or university in the areas of photography, illustration, graphic design, or hold a related art background
- Knowledge of QuarkXpress, Adobe Photoshop, and Adobe Illustrator
- Ability to work under tight deadlines and in a fast-paced environment

- Create artwork for regional magazine editorials and advertising
- Meet deadlines for four magazines simultaneously
- Get up close and personal with your Mac
- Learn more about QuarkXpress, Photoshop, and Illustrator Everyday
